

Commercial Truck Driver: Job Description

With the paid **Commercial Truck Driver** here at Delaware Bulldozing Corp, applicants can look forward to learning about all aspects of trucking from experienced operators, including but not limited to pre-trip inspections, vehicle operation both on-road and on construction sites, with the potential for minor heavy equipment operation.

Valid CDL Class A or B permits/licenses are required for this position. Those with a Class B permit/license can expect to operate Mack tri-axle dump trucks, hauling aggregate (gravel, sand, stone) product to and from construction sites (no more than 20-ton loads).



Those with a Class A permit/license (in addition to all work covered under a Class B) can expect to operate Mack tractors with a tag-along 20-ton trailer. Additionally, both Class A and B drivers must be somewhat adept at heavy equipment operation, as they are expected to load their own trucks.

Drivers are fully responsible for routine service and repairs on the trucks they drive, including but not limited to tire/fluids change, servicing, and possible emergency repairs both on the side of the road, or in the shop.

Expected work hours include punctual 7:00AM arrival, working until 5:00PM with small breaks throughout the day, with a ½ hour lunch period included. This position has the possible opportunity of long-term employment post-internship.
