

The paid **General Laborer** internship here at Delaware Bulldozing Corp will not only have you laying foundations in the literal sense but will also help lay the first building blocks in your life for future employment opportunities.



With a multitude of hands-on learning tasks to perform and experience, knowledge gained here can be applied to various aspects of life, both on and off the jobsite.

Potential interns/employees can expect to be involved in all aspects of initial construction, including but not limited to:

- sitework grading and excavation
- earthmoving
- foundation work
- utility pipelines
- drainage projects
- driveway/road construction
- minor landscaping, with the possibility of heavy equipment maintenance/operation.



Specific tasks an applicant can expect to perform are:

- assisting in trench excavation and grade control
- backfilling foundations with stone
- spreading stone, gravel, and topsoil with hand tools
- installing underground septic & drain systems

Applicants must be relatively physically fit and expect to perform manual labor such as lifting heavy objects, and operating hand tools/hand equipment.

A good laborer in time learns to work closely with the operator, often communicating using hand signals.



The laborer is a key link in the progression of the job, having decent math skills to use a rotary laser level, performing simple differential leveling and the ability to read plans.

Expected work hours include punctual 7:00AM arrival working until 5:00PM with small breaks throughout the day, with a ½ hour lunch period included. All applicants must have a valid Class D Driver's License. This position has the possible opportunity of long-term employment post-internship.
